


COUNCIL OF THE DISTRICT OF COLUMBIA

NOTICE

Pursuant to Section 412 of the District of Columbia Self-Government and Governmental Reorganization Act, PL 93-198, (the Act), the Council of the District of Columbia adopted Bill No. 1-52 on first and second readings July 1, 1975, and July 15, 1975, respectively. Following the signature of the Mayor on August 4, 1975, this legislation was assigned Act No. 1-38, published in the August 15, 1975, edition of the D. C. Register, and transmitted to both Houses of Congress for a 30-day review, in accordance with Section 602(c)(1) of the Act.

The Council of the District of Columbia hereby gives notice that the 30-day Congressional review period has expired and, therefore, cites the following legislation as D. C. Law No. 1-26, effective October 30, 1975.

To eliminate all ethnic references in the laws of the District of Columbia relating to education.

Be it enacted by the Council of the District of Columbia,
That this act may be cited as the "Ethnic Reference Repeal Act".

Sec. 2. The following Acts or parts of Acts are repealed:

(a) (1) The fifth paragraph of section 3 of the Act entitled "An Act to fix and regulate the salaries of teachers, school officers, and other employees of the board of education of the District of Columbia," approved June 20, 1906 (D.C. Code, sec. 31-110);

(2) The third paragraph of section 7 of such Act (D.C. Code, sec. 31-115);

(b) The following sections of the Revised Statutes of the United States relating to the District of Columbia, approved June 22, 1874:

(1) Section 281 (D.C. Code, sec. 31-1110);

(2) Section 282 (D.C. Code, sec. 31-1111);

(3) Section 306 (D.C. Code, sec. 31-1112); and,

(4) Section 310 (D.C. Code, sec. 31-1113).

Sec. 3. Section 283 of the Revised Statutes of the United States relating to the District of Columbia (D.C. Code, sec. 31-1109) is amended by striking out "schools for colored children by persons disposed to aid in the elevation of the colored

population in the District" and inserting in lieu thereof "public schools of the District of Columbia".

Sec. 4. This act shall be effective at the end of the thirty-day period provided for Congressional review of acts of the Council of the District of Columbia in section 602(c) of the District of Columbia Self-Government and Governmental Reorganization Act.
