IN THE COUNCIL OF THE DISTRICT OF COLUMBIA

DECEMBER 27, 1994

To amend title 16 of the District of Columbia Code to establish a Court-Appointed Special Advocate Program to provide trained volunteers for children in court proceedings to insure appropriate service and case planning are provided, to provide that the program be administered by the Family Division of the Superior Court of the District of Columbia, to require certain annual reports, to authorize the Superior Court Board of Judges to adopt rules governing the implementation and operation of the program, to provide immunity from liability for certain persons for certain acts or omissions, to authorize the court to appoint a special advocate under certain circumstances, and to provide a limited exception to the confidentiality of court records.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE DISTRICT OF COLUMBIA, That this act may be cited as the "Court-Appointed Special Advocate Program Act of 1994".
