

AN ACT

IN THE COUNCIL OF THE DISTRICT OF COLUMBIA

To amend the District of Columbia Procurement Practices Act of 1985 to increase the small purchase authority for the Metropolitan Police Department and the Office of the Chief Technology Officer to \$500,000, and to \$100,000 for all other departments, agencies, and instrumentalities of the District of Columbia.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE DISTRICT OF COLUMBIA, That this act may be cited as the “Procurement Practices Small Purchase Amendment Act of 2002”.

Sec. 2. Section 321 of the District of Columbia Procurement Practices Act of 1985, effective February 27, 1998 (D.C. Law 12-50; D.C. Official Code § 2-303.21), is amended by striking the number “\$25,000” and inserting the phrase “\$500,000 for the Metropolitan Police Department and the Office of the Chief Technology Officer, and \$100,000 for all other departments, agencies, instrumentalities, and employees” in its place.

Sec. 3. The Council adopts the attached fiscal impact statement as the fiscal impact statement required by section 602(c)(3) of the District of Columbia Home Rule Act, approved December 24 1973 (87 Stat. 813; D.C. Official Code § 1-206.02(c)(3)).

Sec. 4. This act shall take effect following approval by the Mayor (or in the event of veto by the Mayor, action by the Council to override the veto), a 30-day period of Congressional review as provided in section 602(c)(1) of the District of Columbia Home Rule Act, approved
