To amend the Advisory Neighborhood Commissions Act of 1975 to increase from \$400 to \$1,000, the maximum amount of funds that an Advisory Neighborhood Commission may receive annually from an individual without specific authorization from the Council.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE DISTRICT OF COLUMBIA, That this act may be cited as the "Advisory Neighborhood Commissions Annual Contribution Amendment Act of 2001".

Sec. 2. Section 13(l) of the Advisory Neighborhood Commissions Act of 1975, effective March 26, 1976 (D.C. Law 1-58; D.C. Official Code § 1-309.10(l)), is amended by striking the number "\$400" wherever it appears and inserting the number "\$1,000" in its place.

This act shall take effect following approval by the Mayor (or in the event of veto by the Mayor, action by the Council to override the veto), a 30-day period of Congressional review as provided in section 602(c)(1) of the District of Columbia Home Rule Act, approved December
