To amend the District of Columbia Procurement Practices Act of 1985 to authorize the Chief Procurement Officer to award procurement contracts to vendors who agree to adopt the pricing of a vendor who maintains a pricing agreement or schedule with any federal agency.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE DISTRICT OF COLUMBIA, That this act may be cited as the "Procurement Practices Negotiated Pricing Amendment Act of 2001".

Sec. 2. Section 305(a) of the District of Columbia Procurement Practices Act of 1985, effective February 21, 1986 (D.C. Law 6-85; D.C. Official Code § 2-303.05), is amended as follows.

§ 2-303.05

(a) Paragraph (3) is amended by striking the word "or" at the end.

(b) A new paragraph (3A) is added to read as follows:

"(3A) The contract is with a vendor who agrees to adopt the same pricing schedule for the same services or goods as that of a vendor who maintains a price agreement or schedule with any federal agency, if no contract executed under this paragraph authorizes a price higher than is contained in the contract between the federal agency and the vendor; or".

Sec. 3. The Council adopts the fiscal impact statement in the committee report as the fiscal impact statement required by section 602(c)(3) of the District of Columbia Home Rule Act, approved December 24, 1973 (87 Stat. 813; D.C. Official Code § 1-206.02(c)(3)).

Sec. 4. This act shall take effect following approval by the Mayor (or in the event of a veto by the Mayor, action by the Council to override the veto), a 30-day period of Congressional review as provided in section 602(c)(1) of the District of Columbia Home Rule Act, approved
