D.C. Law 2-78

"Paternity Procedures Clarifying Amendment  
Act of 1978"

Pursuant to Section 412 of the District of Columbia Self-Government and Governmental Reorganization Act, (PL 93-198) the Act, the Council of the District of Columbia adopted Bill No. 2-232 on first and second readings February 21, 1978 and March 7, 1978, respectively. Following expiration of the ten-day period provided the Mayor, in which no action was taken, pursuant to Section 404(e) of the Act, this legislation was assigned Act No. 2-172, published in the May 5, 1978, edition of the D.C. Register and transmitted to both Houses of Congress for a 30-day review, in accordance with Section 602 (c) (1) of the Act.

The Council of the District of Columbia hereby gives notice that the 30-day Congressional review period has expired and, therefore cites the following legislation as D.C. Law 2-78, effective June 13, 1978.

IN THE COUNCIL OF THE DISTRICT OF COLUMBIA

June 13, 1978

To amend the laws of the District of Columbia affecting children born out of wedlock in order to clarify that a child born out of wedlock claiming to a deceased parents' estate simply needs to establish a parent/child relationship.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE DISTRICT OF COLUMBIA, That this act may be cited as the "Paternity Procedures Clarifying Amendment Act of 1978".

Sec. 2. Section 19-316 of the District of Columbia Code is amended as follows:

(a) by striking "by judicial process or pursuant to sec. 19-318";

(b) by striking "issue" and inserting in lieu thereof "heirs"; and

(c) by striking "descendants" and inserting in lieu thereof "heirs".

Sec. 3. This act shall become effective as provided for acts of the Council of the District of Columbia in section 602(c) of the District of Columbia Self-Government and Governmental Reorganization Act.
