D.C. LAW 4-61

"Closing of a Portion of a Public Alley in Square 78 and Official Purposes Funds Amendment Act of 1981".

Pursuant to Section 412 of the District of Columbia Self-Government and Governmental Reorganization Act, P. L. 93-198, "the Act", the Council of the District of Columbia adopted Bill No. 4-264 on first and second readings, September 15, 1981 and September 29, 1981, respectively. Following the signature of the Mayor on October 30, 1981, this legislation was assigned Act No. 4-107, published in the November 6, 1981 edition of the D.C. Register, (Vol. 28 page 4771) and transmitted to Congress on November 2, 1981 for a 30-day review, in accordance with Section 602 (c)(1) of the Act.

The Council of the District of Columbia hereby gives notice that the 30-day Congressional Review Period has expired, and therefore, cites this enactment as D.C. Law 4-61, effective January 26, 1982.

D.C. ACT 4 - 107

IN THE COUNCIL OF THE DISTRICT OF COLUMBIA

To order the closing of a portion of a public alley abutting lots 38, 817, 837, and 838 in Square 78, bounded by K Street, N.W., I Street, N.W., 20th Street, N.W., and 21st Street, N.W. (S.O. 80-281) (Ward 2), and to authorize the expenditure of funds by the City Administrator of the District of Columbia for official purposes.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE DISTRICT OF COLUMBIA, That this act may be cited as the "Closing of a Portion of a Public Alley in Square 78 and Official Purposes Funds Amendment Act of 1981".

Sec. 2. The Council of the District of Columbia finds that:

(a) A public hearing was held on May 7, 1981, concerning the proposed closing of a portion of a public alley abutting lots 38, 817, 837, and 838 in Square 78, bounded by 20th Street, N.W., 21st Street, N.W., H Street, N.W., and I Street, N.W., as shown on a plat filed in the Office of the Surveyor of the District of Columbia (S.O. 80-281).

(b) The proposed closing was referred to the National Capital Planning Commission for its recommendation.

(c) The portion of the public alley referred to in

ction (a) should be closed.

Sec. 3. Pursuant to section 1 of The Street Readjustment Act of the District of Columbia, approved December 15, 1932 (47 Stat. 747; D.C. Code, sec. 7-401) the closing of the public alley in Square 78, as shown on the plat filed in the Office of the Surveyor of the District of Columbia (S.O. 80-281) is ordered closed, with the title to the land to revert, without cost, to the owners of the abutting property.

Sec. 4. In accordance with the procedures set forth in section 4 of The Street Readjustment Act of the District of Columbia, approved December 15, 1932 (47 Stat. 749; D.C. Code, sec. 7-404), and immediately after the effective date of the Closing of a Portion of a Public Alley in Square 78 of 1981 ("act"), the Surveyor of the District of Columbia shall publish public notice of this act and shall send a notice to each of the owners of the abutting property at this act has taken effect.

Sec. 5. If no objection is made in writing by any interested party within thirty (30) days after the Surveyor of the District of Columbia has fulfilled the requirements of section 4, the Surveyor of the District of Columbia shall deposit in the Office of the Surveyor of the District of Columbia a copy of this act and the appropriate plat or plats.

Sec. 6. The Secretary to the Council of the District of Columbia shall transmit a certified copy of this act,

upon its effective date, to the Mayor of the District of Columbia and to the Surveyor of the District of Columbia.

Sec. 7. The first sentence of section 26 of An Act to authorize certain programs and activities of the government of the District of Columbia, and for other purposes, approved October 26, 1973 (87 Stat. 509; D.C. Code, secs. 1-262a & 31-1122) is amended to read as follows:


"The Mayor of the District of Columbia, the Chairman and Members of the Council of the District of Columbia, the Chief Judge of the District of Columbia Court of Appeals, the Chief Judge of the Superior Court of the District of Columbia, the Executive Officer of the District of Columbia Court System, the Superintendent of Schools, the City Administrator, the Director of the District of Columbia Public Library, and the Chief Executive Officer of the University of the District of Columbia are authorized to provide for the expenditure, within the limits of specified annual appropriation, of funds for appropriate purposes related to their official capacity as they may respectively deem necessary."

Sec. 8. This act shall take effect after a thirty (30)-day period of Congressional review following approval by the Mayor (or in the event of veto by the Mayor, action by the Council of the District of Columbia to override the veto) as provided in section 602(c)(1) of the District of Columbia Self-Government and Governmental Reorganization Act, approved December 24, 1973 (87 Stat. 813; D.C. Code,

1-147(c)(1)).
