D.C. LAW 5-18

"Cable Television Communications Act of 1981
Amendment Act of 1983".

Pursuant to Section 412 of the District of Columbia Self-Government and Governmental Reorganization Act, P. L. 93-198, "the Act", the Council of the District of Columbia adopted Bill No. 5-148 on first and second readings, May 10, 1983 and May 24, 1983, respectively. Following the signature of the Mayor on June 9, 1983, this legislation was assigned Act No. 5-35, published in the July 8, 1983 edition of the D.C. Register, (Vol. 30 page 3326) and transmitted to Congress June 13, 1983 for a 30-day review, in accordance with Section 602 (c)(1) of the Act.

The Council of the District of Columbia hereby gives notice that the 30-day Congressional Review Period has expired, and therefore, cites this enactment as D.C. Law 5-18, effective August 2, 1983.

IN THE COUNCIL OF THE DISTRICT OF COLUMBIA

To extend the time in which the District of Columbia Cable Design Commission shall develop a Request for Proposal, cable franchise application, and procedures for the granting of a franchise pursuant to the Cable Television Communications Act of 1981.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE DISTRICT OF COLUMBIA, That this act may be cited as the "Cable Television Communications Act of 1981 Amendment Act of 1983".


Sec. 2. Section 5(d) of the Cable Television Communications Act of 1981, effective August 21, 1982 (D.C. Law 4-142; D.C. Code, sec. 43-1804(d)), is amended to read as follows:


"(d) Develop and submit to the Council before July 1, 1983, a Request for Proposal, cable franchise application, and a procedure for the granting of franchise or franchises which shall guarantee, to the greatest extent possible, a cable system which will provide local community access and full minority participation in all phases of development and maintenance of any cable system in the District of Columbia. The chairperson of the Cable Design Commission shall submit to the Council on April 1, 1983, May 1, 1983, and June 1, 1983, reports on the progress of the Commission with respect to completing the tasks required by this subsection."

Sec. 3. This act shall take effect after a 30-day

period of Congressional review following approval by the Mayor (or in the event of veto by the Mayor, action by the Council of the District of Columbia to override the veto) as provided in section 602(c)(1) of the District of Columbia Self-Government and Governmental Reorganization Act, approved December 24, 1973 (87 Stat. 813; D.C. Code sec. 1-233(c)(1)).
