#### D. C. LAW 6-43

"District of Columbia Government Comprehensive Merit Personnel Act of 1978/Retirement Annuity Pay Reduction Exception Act of 1985".

Pursuant to Section 412 of the District of Columbia Self-Government and Governmental Reorganization Act, P. L. 93-198, "the Act", the Council of the District of Columbia adopted Bill No. 6-68 on first and second readings, June 25, 1985, and July 9, 1985, respectively. Following the signature of the Mayor on July 16, 1985, this legislation was assigned Act No. 6-61, published in the August 2, 1985, edition of the D.C. Register, (Vol. 32 page 4484) and transmitted to Congress on July 24, 1985 for a 30-day review, in accordance with Section 602 (c)(1) of the Act.

The Council of the District of Columbia hereby gives notice that the 30-day Congressional Review Period has expired, and therefore, cites this enactment as D.C. Law 6-43, effective October 5, 1985.

## D.C. ACT 6 - 61

IN THE COUNCIL OF THE DISTRICT OF COLUMBIA

# JUL 1 6 1985

To amend the District of Columbia Government Comprehensive Merit Personnel Act of 1978 to provide that District government employees who receive an annuity under any retirement system of the uniformed services of the United States shall have their compensation reduced only when their income from their District government position plus their annuity exceeds the amount payable for step 1 of Grade 15 in the District Service Schedule 1.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE DISTRICT OF COLUMBIA, That this act may be cited as the "District of Columbia Government Comprehensive Merit Personnel Act of 1978/Retirement Annuity Pay Reduction Exception Act of 1985".

- Sec. 2. The District of Columbia Government

  Comprehensive Merit Personnel Act of 1978, effective March

  3, 1979 (D.C. Law 2-139; D.C. Code, sec. 1-601 et seq.), is
  amended as follows:
- (a) Section 1103 (D.C. Code, sec. 1-612.3) is amended as follows:
  - (1) Subsection (b) is amended to read as follows:
- "(b) The pay of an individual receiving an annuity under any federal or District government civilian retirement system selected for employment in the District government on or after the effective date of this title shall be reduced

D.C. Code sec. 1-6 (1986 sup by the amount of annuity allocable to the period of employment as a reemployed annuitant.".

- (2) A new subsection (c) is added to read as follows:
- "(c) The pay of an individual receiving an annuity under any retirement system of the uniformed services of the United States selected for employment in the District government on or after the effective date of this title shall be reduced by only that amount of the individual's salary which when added to his or her annuity exceeds the basic pay then in effect for step 1 of a Grade 15 of the District Service Schedule 1.".
- (b) Section 3202(e)(6) (D.C. Code, sec.

  1-633.2(a)(5)(G)) is amended by inserting after the phrase (1986 supp.)

  "5531(2)," the phrase "5532,".
- Sec. 3. This act shall take effect after a 30-day period of Congressional review following approval by the Mayor (or in the event of veto by the Mayor, action by the Council of the District of Columbia to override the veto) as provided in section 602(c)(1) of the District of Columbia Self-Government and Governmental Reorganization Act,

approved December 24, 1973 (87 Stat. 813; D.C. Code, sec. 1-233(c)(1)).
