"Retired Police Officer Redeployment
Amendment Act of 1989".

Pursuant to Section 412 of the District of Columbia Self-Government and Governmental Reorganization Act, P. L. 93-198, "the Act", the Council of the District of Columbia adopted Bill No. 8-308 on first and second readings, December 5, 1989, and December 19, 1989, respectively. Following the signature of the Mayor on January 11, 1990, this legislation was assigned Act No. 8-146, published in the January 26, 1990, edition of the D.C. Register, (Vol. 37 page 786) and transmitted to Congress on January 23, 1990 for a 30-day review, in accordance with Section 602(c)(1) of the Act.

The Council of the District of Columbia hereby gives notice that the 30-day Congressional Review Period has expired, and therefore, cites this enactment as D.C. Law 8-95, effective March 15, 1990.

AN ACT

D.C. ACT 8 - 146

IN THE COUNCIL OF THE DISTRICT OF COLUMBIA

JAN 11 1990

To allow a retired member of the Metropolitan Police force to be eligible for rehire as a temporary full time or temporary part time police officer without annuitant liability for salary earned from the District of Columbia government or negative impact on unfunded liability of the District of Columbia Police Officers and Firefighters' Retirement Fund, and to provide that a retired officer deployed under this act be vested with full police powers.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE DISTRICT OF COLUMBIA, That this act may be cited as the "Retired Police Officer Redeployment Amendment Act of 1989".

Sec. 2. (a) Except for a disability annuitant, a police officer retired from the Metropolitan Police force shall be eligible for rehire at the discretion of the Chief of the Metropolitan Police force as a fully sworn temporary full time or temporary part time police officer without jeopardy to the retirement benefits of the police officer.

(b) A retired police officer who is rehired under this act shall be vested with full police powers including, but not limited to, the authority to carry a firearm.

(c) Service under this act shall not count as creditable service for the purposes of section 12(c) of An Act Making Appropriations to provide for the expenses of the government of the District of Columbia for the fiscal year ending June thirtieth, nineteen hundred and seventeen, and for other purposes, approved September 1, 1916 (39 Stat. 676; D.C. Code, sec. 4-610) ("Policemen and Firemen's Retirement and Disability Act").

Sec. 3. Section 12(n) of the Policemen and Firemen's Retirement and Disability Act, approved September 1, 1916 (39 Stat. 676; D.C. Code, sec. 4-629(e)), is amended by adding the following sentence at the end:


"The provisions of this subsection shall not apply to an annuitant employed by the District of Columbia government under the Retired Police Officer Redeployment Amendment Act of 1989".

Sec. 4. (a) This act shall take effect after a 30-day period of Congressional review following approval by the Mayor (or in the event of veto by the Mayor, action by the Council of the District of Columbia to override the veto) as provided in section 602(c)(1) of the District of Columbia Self-Government and Governmental Reorganization Act, approved December 24, 1973 (87 Stat. 813; D.C. Code, sec. 1-233(c)(1)), and publication in either the District of Columbia Register, the District of Columbia Statutes-at-Large, or the District of Columbia Municipal Regulations.

(b) This act expires on April 1, 1992.
